The following sets out the membership agreement for Kintbury Table Tennis Club (KTTC):

- Each member pays an annual membership fee of £45 (seniors) or £22.50 (juniors) payable in advance. The membership year runs from 1<sup>st</sup> June to 31<sup>st</sup> May.
- Each team player pays a match fee of £4 for each NDTTA team match played. Match fees are applicable for both home and away matches, league matches and Pembroke/Emmanuel cup matches. Match fees are payable at the end of the NDTTA playing season.
- Each team is entitled to have a reserved table slot for all their home fixtures in the league and cup competitions.
- KTTC enter as many teams as requested by members and will pay for NDTTA team entry fees.
- Individual players are responsible for their own NDTTA individual membership fees and Table Tennis England membership fees. All players must have fully paid up memberships of NDTTA and Table Tennis England before playing for KTTC in a competition.
- All individual members can make use of unallocated tables for practice sessions free of charge. Non-member guests can participate in these sessions and a fee of £3 per session is payable for each quest.
- KTTC will make booking and financial arrangements with the Jubilee Centre for the main sports hall one weekday evening (currently Thursday) from 7:30pm onwards. Selfservice access arrangements will apply and members using the facilities are responsible for ensuring the centre is secured on exit. If due to unavoidable circumstances the centre is not available for KTTC use on a designated day, then KTTC will advise accordingly.
- KTTC may organise structured coaching sessions for the benefit of members and nonmembers and has the right to allocate table time for the running of such activities.
  KTTC will ensure that there is a minimum of one table available for practising by members on days when there are no matches.
- KTTC will provide the following equipment:
  - Table tennis tables and nets
  - o Barriers to separate playing areas for each table
  - o Dividing net between the badminton courts
  - Other venue facilities as provided by Jubilee Centre (toilets, kitchen facilities, etc.). If not provided by Jubilee Centre, KTTC will provide chairs for players and umpire, umpire's table.
- KTTC will make arrangements with Jubilee Centre for the storage of the above equipment.
- Teams to provide their own table tennis balls for competitions. Members to provide their own table tennis balls for practice sessions.
- KTTC may invest in coaching equipment which is available for use by members at no extra charge. There is no obligation for KTTC to provide specific items of coaching equipment.
- This membership agreement is subject to change and the currently applicable agreement will be published on the KTTC website (http://kintburyttc.org.uk).
